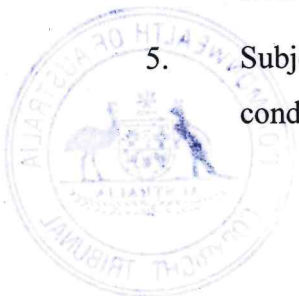

THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS BY CONSENT THAT:

Final Scheme

1. CRA is to serve on PPCA its proposed updated scheme reflecting the Tribunal's judgment dated 10 December 2025 by 27 February 2026.
2. PPCA is to serve on CRA its proposed updated scheme reflecting the Tribunal's judgment dated 10 December 2025 by 20 March 2026.
3. The parties are to file and serve an updated scheme reflecting the Tribunal's judgment dated 10 December 2025 and highlight any terms or conditions which are not agreed by 24 April 2026.
4. The parties are to file and serve short written submissions not exceeding five (5) pages in length addressing the terms and conditions which are not agreed by 4 May 2026.
5. Subject to further order of the Tribunal, the Tribunal will determine any terms and conditions which are not agreed by the parties on the papers, without an oral hearing.




Confidentiality

6. Further to the orders made by the Tribunal on 6 May 2025, pursuant to s 163(2)(b) of the *Copyright Act 1968* (Cth), any documents filed, tendered or otherwise introduced into evidence in the proceedings that are marked or listed as “Confidential” or “Highly Confidential” in accordance with the confidentiality regime ordered by the Tribunal on 10 October 2023 (**Confidentiality Regime**) not be published or made available and not be disclosed to any person or entity except to those to whom disclosure can be made under and in accordance with the Confidentiality Regime.
7. In the event that any member of the public applies to inspect any documents filed, tendered or otherwise introduced into evidence in these proceedings, the parties will first be notified of the request and the documents in question and given the opportunity to make submissions with respect to the documents which are the subject of a request for inspection.

THE TRIBUNAL NOTES THAT:

8. Nothing in these orders displaces the orders made by the Tribunal on 10 October 2023 or any *inter partes* arrangements made in writing as regards the handling of confidential material.
9. Liberty to apply on three (3) days’ notice.
